
Through discipleship and hands-on service, NL4Y continues to raise up young leaders marked by faith and resilience.

Its legacy is one of grace, unwavering truth, and a commitment to seeing young people not just survive—but thrive in the calling God has placed on their lives.









# Carry 12

## Disciple and Support Groups

NL4Y groups are designed around our Carry 12 concept in which each group carries 12 young adults. This is a space for young adults to come together and study the word in a way that breeds genuine connection.

During home group, people will have time to commune. They will then study the word. Once a month, they will do a service project for the local community. The hope is that young adults will plug into a church and a home group. Home group leaders will be adults from various, local churches.



# Young Adult Events

NL4Y will plan and run various young adult events. They will advertise these events on social media and to the local churches. These events are fun activities that are meant to be a relaxing space for Christian, young adults to come together and meet new people.

Examples of events are pickleball tournaments, “painting with a twist”, gardening night, board game nights...

# Flat Out

Soaking Worship Services



## Flat-Out Worship

Lying flat before God—is a deeply reverent act seen throughout Scripture, especially in moments of divine encounter, awe, and surrender. It reflects a posture of total humility and submission to Christ’s glory.

In both the Old and New Testaments, falling face down is a physical response to the overwhelming presence of God. When God appeared to Abram to establish His covenant, Abram “fell facedown, and God spoke with him” (Genesis 17:3), signifying reverence and submission. Similarly, in Leviticus 9:24, after fire came from the Lord to consume the offering, “all the people saw it, they shouted and fell on their faces,” overwhelmed by His glory.

These moments aren't choreographed rituals—they were spontaneous, visceral reactions to divine holiness. Moses, Aaron, Ezekiel, and others also fell face down when encountering God’s presence, showing that this posture transcends culture and era.

# Immersed

Youth Conference + Camping Experience



**Day 1: Wade In** – Let go of distractions and step into God’s presence.

**Day 2: Submerged** – Discover who you are in Christ through worship

**Day 3: Carried by the Current** – Trust God’s leading and walk in purpose.

**Day 4: Rise and Overflow** – Be empowered to ready to impact others.

## Theme: “Deeper Still”

- This theme invites young adults to move beyond surface-level faith and dive into the deep waters of God’s presence. Inspired by Psalm 42:7—“Deep calls to deep in the roar of your waterfalls”—“Deeper Still” challenges young adults to explore the depths of worship, identity, and calling. Each day of the camp can focus on a different layer of spiritual depth
- Immersed Youth Conference + Camping Experiences offer a powerful blend of spiritual awakening, outdoor adventure, and deep community. These multi-day events are designed to help young adults unplug from distractions and immerse themselves in the presence of God through worship, teaching, and nature.
- Young adults engage in a mix of activities that foster both fun and faith. Days are filled with energetic worship sessions, breakout teachings, and team-building games, while evenings often feature bonfires, testimonies, and moments of quiet reflection under the stars. The camping environment strips away the noise of everyday life, allowing youth to connect with Christ in a raw and personal way. Whether hiking trails, praying in small groups, or singing around a fire, these experiences cultivate spiritual growth, lasting friendships, and a renewed sense of purpose.

# Battle Ready

## Musical Talent Events



Christian Battle of the Bands events blend musical talent with spiritual purpose, offering a dynamic platform for young artists to glorify God through competition, creativity, and community. These gatherings are more than entertainment—they're evangelistic opportunities wrapped in rhythm and praise.

At their core, Christian Battle of the Bands events invite local worship teams, youth bands, and solo artists to perform live sets that range from contemporary Christian music to gospel, rock, and worship. Each band typically plays two or three songs, and the audience votes for their favorite. The winning group may receive a trophy, studio time, or a chance to perform at a larger event. But the real prize is the impact: these events often include a short gospel message, testimonies, and prayer, making them powerful outreach tools for youth ministries and churches.

These competitions foster community among believers and provide a safe, uplifting space for young musicians to grow in both skill and faith. They also attract seekers and skeptics who might not attend a traditional church service but are drawn to the energy and authenticity of live music. Whether hosted by schools, churches, or ministries, Christian Battle of the Bands events are a creative way to celebrate the gospel, amplify young voices, and invite transformation through the power of song.

# The Arts

The NL4Y Drama Arts Program is a vibrant outlet for youth to express faith, creativity, and truth through performance. Rooted in the belief that storytelling can transform hearts, the program equips young people to write, act, and direct original skits, plays, and spoken word pieces that reflect the gospel and real-life struggles. Whether dramatizing biblical stories or modern testimonies, students learn to use their voices and bodies to communicate hope, conviction, and redemption.

Beyond the stage, the program fosters spiritual growth and teamwork. Rehearsals become spaces for discipleship, prayer, and character development, as youth learn to support one another and steward their gifts. Performances often take place at NL4Y events, camps, and outreach nights, where audiences are moved by the authenticity and power of the message. The Drama Arts Program isn't just about acting—it's about activating purpose, building confidence, and proclaiming Christ through the art of story.

# Missionary Care

Recent research and surveys among long-term missionaries have revealed a heartbreaking trend: a significant number quietly step away from their faith in the years following their return “home.” The transition from the mission field back to life in their passport country – often called “re-entry” or “reverse culture shock” – is frequently more difficult than the original move overseas.

Tragically, most local churches and sending agencies are not yet equipped to walk alongside returning missionaries with the depth of care this season requires. As a result, many faithful servants who once thrived on the field end up isolated, discouraged, and – in the worst cases – walking away from the faith they once proclaimed.

At NL4Y, returning missionaries are not seen as projects to “fix” or heroes on a pedestal, but as beloved brothers and sisters deserving rest, listening ears, and the same grace they have extended to others around the world.



# A Place of Refuge

Youth Care

NL4Y will provide a place to call home for teenagers aging out of the foster care system.

- New Life will be a place of refuge for these young adults who age out of the foster care system.
- Students have bi-weekly meetings with a dedicated mentor (New Life will provide mentorship programs).
- They can qualify for up to a year of free housing as long as they are either working or a full-time student.

# Dunked

## Baptism Services

Getting baptized at New Life 4 Youth is more than a symbolic act—it's a full-body declaration of transformation. Known affectionately as “getting dunked,” this moment marks a powerful turning point in a young person's journey with Christ. Surrounded by peers, mentors, and leaders who've walked alongside them, youth step into the water ready to leave behind the old and rise into the new. The atmosphere is electric with celebration, prayer, and worship, often followed by hugs, cheers, and tears of joy.

At NL4Y, baptism isn't just a ritual—it's a testimony. Before each dunk, youth often share a few words about what Jesus has done in their lives, giving glory to God and encouraging others who may be on the edge of decision. The act of going under the water represents dying to sin, and emerging symbolizes new life in Christ.

It's a moment of surrender and empowerment, often captured in photos and memories that last a lifetime. For many, it's the highlight of their time at NL4Y—a sacred collision of faith, community, and the Spirit's work in real time.

Hosting weddings at NL4Y (New Life 4 Youth) offers couples a unique opportunity to celebrate their covenant in a Christ-centered environment surrounded by natural beauty and spiritual purpose.
